Our council is working to promote pollinator habitat in the Magic Valley. This program will plant thousands of flowering plants in the ground, educate participants on pollinator habitat and identification, and inspire community engagement and citizen science for pollinator counts and identification.

Each selection will offer a unique addition to your garden. Each has flowers that will attract a variety of pollinators and that should bloom at various times during the summer.

The partners in the Magic Valley Pollinator Project anticipate that we will offer selections of these pollinating plants next winter for purchase and pick up in May of 2023.



Pollinator Mix #1 | Cottage Garden

This pollinator mix includes cosmos, black-eyed susans, hollyhock, milkweed, shasta daisies, poppy (Lauren's grape), marigold (coco) and zinnia (cactus).

Pollinator Mix #2 | Medicinal Flowers

This pollinator mix includes echinacea, oregano, milkweed, bronze fennel, yarrow (moonshine), sage, calendula, catmint.





Pollinator Mix #3 | Vegetable Companions

This pollinator mix includes nasturtium, sweet alyssum, marigold (sparky mix), milkweed, zinnia, cosmos (sulphur), borage and calendula.

Pollinator Mix #4 | Idaho Natives

This pollinator mix includes lupine, bee balm, rocky mountain penstemon, yarrow, blue flax, erigeron, black-eyed susan, and milkweed



Would you like to see more Monarch Butterflies?

Monarchs are incredible migrating pollinators that thrive on milkweed. The Monarch caterpillars feed exclusively on the leaves of milkweed, the only host plant for this iconic butterfly species.
